Staggered Start Of School Year For XHS Students

On Thursday, August 17, the High School will be open for **ONLY** ninth grade students. We will operate on a modified bell schedule, but you will have the opportunity to go through an entire day as the only students in the building. On Friday, August 18, we will have **ALL** students in all four grades in the building together.

All Grade 9 students should report to the cafeteria upon arrival to school and report to their Advisory Period after the 7:35am bell. Advisory Period assignments will be posted in the high school's lobby and will be posted in the Class of 2027 Google Classroom. Instructions to ninth grade students on how to access the Google Classroom for the class of 2027 will be sent via Final Forms email. After arrival in their Advisory Period, Grade 9 students will participate in our Freshman Orientation Program, after which students will go through their full schedule for the remainder of the school day.

On Friday, August 18, the High School will be open for **ALL** students. All students should report to the cafeteria upon arrival to school and report to their Advisory Period after the 7:35am bell. Advisory Period assignments will be posted in the High School's Main Lobby and will be posted in the Google Classroom of each class. Advisory Period will begin at 7:35am, and all students will then go through their full schedule, being dismissed at 2:28pm.



Back to School Guide (District Information)

The Xenia Community Schools has added an informational Back to School Guide on the District website to assist parents and students with back to school questions and concerns. Information on such topics as Final Forms, First Day & Open Houses, School Supplies, School Information, Bus Routes, School Fees, Student Nutrition Services, Student Health Services and Kindergarten and Preschool is available for review. Immunization Requirement For 2023-24 Seniors

The Ohio Department of Health now requires that all students entering 12th grade have a second dose of meningococcal vaccine (MVC4) prior to the first day of the school year. If the first dose of the meningococcal vaccine was administered on or after the student's 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

Please contact your child's physician, the Five Rivers Health Center (Xenia) (708-3400) or local pharmacies such as Walgreens (376-0631) or Walmart (376-3700) to schedule an immunization. If you have additional questions, please contact the Greene County Health Department or the Ohio Department of Health website and type "immunization" in the search engine box.

All XHS 2023-24 Grade 12 students must provide a record of this immunization (via a receipt or vaccination record) on or before August 17, 2023. Students will be excluded from attendance at school on September 7, 2023 if the immunization record has not been provided.

New Cell Phone Policy

Starting this fall, Xenia High School will begin the use of the YONDR system as a means to help students deal with the stress and distraction of their cell phones. A letter to all families was sent via Final Forms email on July 27, 2023, providing an overview of the program, and answers about the program. A copy of this letter has been posted on the XHS website, under the tab on the left-hand side of the web page entitled **XHS New Cell Phone Policy for 2023-24 School Year**. Basic information regarding the initiation of the YONDR system is as follows:

- On the first day of school, all students will receive a YONDR pouch in their Advisory Period. Students will be shown how to use the pouch, and the disciplinary consequences for not using the pouch will be explained. Students will write their first and last name on their pouch, so that their pouch can be identified. After that, students will be expected to use the pouch each day they are in the building.
- Students will store their phone and ear buds in their YONDR pouch at the beginning of their first period classes. Students will keep their YONDR pouch in their possession, either on their desk or in a pocket, until the end of the day. Students who arrive late to school will be able to secure their phone at the Security Desk in the Main Lobby of the building before they sign in and proceed to class.
- At the end of the school day, students will be able to unlock their YONDR pouch and have access to their phone. If a student is leaving the building before the end of the school day, they will be able to unlock their

YONDR pouch at the Security Desk in the Main Lobby before they leave the building.

Xenia Athletics All Sports Pass 23-24

Xenia Athletics All Sports Passes for the 2023-2024 school year will go on sale August 1! All Sports Passes, which allow for unlimited admission to all Buccaneer MS and HS <u>regular</u> <u>season home sports events</u> for the 2023-24 school year, may be purchased in-person at the Athletics Office from August 1 through August 11 (M-F) from 9:00am-11:00am.

The Athletics office is located in the blue trailer next to the teachers' parking lot at Xenia High School.

Pass Options

- <u>Student Pass</u> \$60 This pass is good for unlimited admission for one student (high school age and younger) to all Buccaneer MS and HS home sports events for the 2023-24 school year. Please note: this does not include postseason or tournament games.
- <u>Adult Pass</u> \$90 This pass is good for unlimited admission for one adult to all Buccaneer MS and HS home sports events for the 2023-24 school year. Please note: this does not include post-season or tournament games. *A 2nd adult pass may be purchased for \$60.*
- **Family Pass** \$250 This pass is good for admission of up to four people per household for all Buccaneer MS and HS home sports events for the 2023-24 school year. Please note: this does not include post-season or tournament games. Additional family members in the same household may be added for \$60 each.
- <u>Senior Citizen Pass</u> Free Senior Citizens (62 years and older) who live in Xenia can receive a "Senior Citizen Pass" for free admission to all MS and HS home events for the 2023-24 school year. Please note: this does not include post-season or tournament games. *All Senior Citizen Passes can be picked up at the Senior Citizen Center located at the YMCA in Xenia.*

Free and Reduced Meals For the 2023-

24 School Year

Get ready for 2023! Once again this school year, Xenia Community School District will participate in Ohio's National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) in our cafeterias.

By participating in CEP, all of our K-8th grade students (ONLY) will continue to receive a free breakfast and lunch meal daily without additional paperwork. As always, all **a** la carte options (including the purchase of a 2nd meal) are still available for purchase. In fact, now is a good time to take advantage of putting money on your student's lunch account so they don't worry about having cash available to make any a la carte purchases.

K-8 students enjoying meals through CEP who may also qualify for a fee waiver, based on need, would need to fill out additional paperwork:

- If you have both K-8 and high school students within your home, you would need to fill out an online free/reduced application to see if all the students in the home qualify for a fee waiver and/or meal benefits. The online free/reduced application can be found at payschoolscentral.com after July 1.
- If you have only K-8 students within your home, you
 may fill out the Household Income Survey form to see
 if you are eligible for a fee waiver. This form can be
 obtained on the District's website under Student
 Nutrition Services, by coming into any office of our K8 buildings, or by requesting a copy via email
 to foodservice@xeniaschools.org.

Both the Household Income Survey and the online Free/Reduced Application are available after July 1, 2023. If you choose to download the Household Survey, you must print, complete, and return it.

Don't forget! Families must fill out a new Household Survey form or a new online application each and every year to

qualify. Even if you qualified the year before, the paperwork will be processed each fall to ensure that meal benefits (grades 9-12) and/or a fee waiver benefit (K-12) can be continued.

Unfortunately, due to state guidelines, Xenia High School does not qualify for the CEP program, and will be exclusively participating in the NSLP. Families of students in grades 9-12 must complete an online free/reduced application that will determine eligibility for: 1) any free or reduced cost meal benefits, as well as 2) a school fee waiver.

The online free/reduced application is available through payschoolscentral.com after July 1, 2023. If you do not already have a PaySchools Central account, you may need to register an account before processing the application.

If you have any questions regarding a student's progress in any of your student's classes, you can call or e-mail your student's teacher for further information. First semester report cards will be distributed to students in Advisory Period on Friday, **January 12**, **2024**, and second semester report cards will be mailed home on **May 31**, **2024**. One Calls will be made near these dates to remind parents that report cards are being distributed and/or mailed.

Student Drop-off and Pickup Reminder

- A reminder for all families who will be dropping off or picking up students this year. When you enter the parking lot to drop your student off, you should turn right, and proceed along the outside of the parking lot until you reach the sidewalk in front of the building. Once there, you can safely release your passengers onto the sidewalk. After your passengers have left your vehicle, you can then proceed to the end of the lot, turn left, and exit the lot.
- When you come to school to pick your student up, the same path should be taken. You should drive along the outside of the parking lot until you are in front of the building, pick up your student, and then proceed to the end of the lot, turn left, and leave through the lot exit area.
- Students should not be dropped off in the staff parking lot, the bus loading zone, or at the apartment complex behind the staff parking lot.
- We ask that you do this because it is the safest way for your student, yourself, and other drivers to drop off and pick up students. We do not want to put students or drivers at risk of an accident. So, please, for the safety of all of our families, follow this procedure. Thank you all in advance for your cooperation.

FirstView App

In partnership with First Student, the District launched the FirstView[®] app, which allows families to track their student's bus in real time throughout the day, setting up notifications when the bus is close, as well as setting up push notifications or email messages for any alerts about your student's bus. It is important for families to note that you must track your student by their route number, not their bus number.

FAQs About The FirstView App:

- Note that you do not need to download an app if you do not have a smartphone. The app is accessible through your browser at <u>firstsviewapp.com</u>!
- For registration purposes, the code for the Xenia Community Schools for the 2023-24 school year is TB2C.
- Having technical issues? Support for the app is available from FirstView by calling 888-889-8920 from 7:00am to 5:00pm (M-F), emailing their Customer Support at <u>support@firstviewapp.com</u>, or by using the in-app "⊠" button.
- Note that we will no longer use One Call to notify families of bus changes. The FirstView app will provide the most timely information for families using their preferred method of communication (text, push notification, or email). Just be sure to set your preferences in the app!



Dayton Children's Health and Wellness Clinic at Warner Middle School/Available To All Xenia Community Schools Students

The Dayton Children's Health and Wellness Clinic at Warner Middle School, provided by Dayton Children's Hospital, offers on-site health services five (5) days a week to any student in the District. Transportation will be available for students to participate in appointments from Xenia High School to the Dayton Children's Health and Wellness Clinic. A pediatrictrained nurse practitioner is available three days a week to provide services and there will also be telehealth services technology that allows a provider to listen to your child's heart, look in their ears and take a peek at their throat, all through the internet on the days when the nurse practitioner is not available.

For example - \$3.00 per week, \$12.00 per month or \$25 per 9 weeks, etc. is acceptable; please adjust payment amounts to be sufficient to completely pay balance due by 5/10/24.

- Fees follow students year after year.
- ONLY CURRENT YEAR FEES can be waived IF qualified.
- Students cannot receive their grade cards, diplomas, or transcripts at GRADUATION or TRANSFER to a new school until ALL Fees are PAID in FULL.
