ABOUT THE ANNUAL SPEECH CONTEST

This is an individual student competition, where students will compose a speech of two to three minutes on the assigned topic. Students will record and submit their speech virtually, and the top three speeches from each category will be invited to deliver their speech in person to a panel of judges who will select the winners!

Any XCS student in grades K-12 can participate in this <u>optional</u> event. Only one speech per student will be considered. Speeches must be about the assigned topic, and less than three (3) minutes in length.

22-23 TOPIC

Kindness, Empathy, and Compassion! Students who are in **grades 3-12 will write a speech** about the importance of kindness, empathy, and compassion, and the impact it has on building a positive community. **K-2 students can read their favorite poem** about kindness, <u>OR</u> complete the 3rd-5th grade option for an extra challenge!

SCORING

All speeches submitted virtually will be <u>scored using a</u> <u>rubric</u> to assess speech content, presentation style, body language, and more. Three finalists per category will be scored by a panel of judges in person on December 12 to determine the winners.
